

Champagne Devaux (1846) is our middle ground combining long ageing and abundant freshness. Ayala (1860), known for their Blanc de Blancs marks our journey's end with their take on the superb 2015 vintage. Sip. sip again and enjoy. All are available as a full glass pour.


WHAT TO DRINK AFTER

Dessert wines always present an issue when dining out. Unless you're weak of will, like us, then it is simply impossible to drink everything you want over the course of a meal. We often read wine lists backwards in anticipation of the sugary delights one can convince company to splurge on at the end of a meal, and in doing so, you are encouraged to do the same. Dessert wines don't behave like red or white wines, instead they are like the 'Champagne of the finale'; rather than arriving, people are leaving, rather than snacking, people are folding their napkins, pushing their cutlery away. And rather than a POP followed by bright fizz and a polite laugh, we seek syrupy goodness, a warming sensation deep within and uproarious merriment. Wines of this magnitude, like the ones listed below, tend to push the boundaries, both socially and with their ability to command your attention and keep it.

Drink full and descend.

SAKE

Sake is a Japanese style of rice wine. The process of production is incredibly complex compared to that of other alcoholic beverages. It is a masterfully created blend of certain types of rice, grown different ways, mould with different properties and water with desirable characteristics. This is all fermented together to create an end product that can behave like wine; some styles are meant to be drunk whilst young, fresh and zippy, whereas some styles are made to age gracefully, revealing layers of texture and depth. Sake is a traditional drink in Japanese culture and has roots dating back to the 3rd century BC. It is no wonder that the world's inspiration for fresh and raw seafood cuts choose to drink such charismatic and satisfying brews as these.

MARCO DE JEREZ AND THE GRAPE PALOMINO

Marco de Jerez is a gorgeous region of rolling hills inland from the Atlantic coast and north from the bay of Cádiz. Of the nine wine-making villages of the region, it's centered on, and is named for the main town, Jerez de la Frontera. The most famous local wine, 'sherry' also takes its name from Jerez. In most places you can see the Atlantic; you can feel it everywhere. Cool, moist, mythical. The lands glisten and twinkle when the sun catches the dazzling chalky soil.

Palomino is one of the white grapes native to Marco de Jerez, and nowadays by far its dominant cultivar. In the wine styles of Jerez, potentially acid-shy Palomino gets plenty of help in filling the hole where acidity should go. In the great vineyards, with quality viticultural values, Palomino naturally gains structural mouthfeel from the textured, earthy but fresh and highly sensual chalk soils. And then, winemaking adds on complex overlays from the region's techniques of ageing in conjunction with moderated oxidative ingress. Air, time and the interplay of flor yeast give secondary compounds.

This one is Unique with a capital 'U'. Couche employs a traditional perpetual solera method to bring complexity and a slight richness to this Cuvée. Elegance is, of course, present but it is that touch of oxidisation that makes this stand out. Much like breathing in a fresh produce market there are enticing wafts from all directions: brioche buns, candied apples, fresh white flowers and far, far into the distance (perhaps even the next market over) someone is roasting nuts. Don't let the nose fool you, zero dosage and bone dry.

WHITE BURGUNDY

Situated in east-central France, Burgundy is synonymous with prestige, intensity and a refined sense of terroir. There's a reason that wines from stunning vintages are so revered and this is a prime example of why they should always be made available (at the right time) for people to enjoy. This is a classic Bourgogne Blanc of outstanding value made from three small plots on the border of Meursault. The bottle age here seamlessly integrates the 20% new oak used during maturation. Imagine being able to drink an apple pie. but someone, rather unforgivably, left out the cinnamon. In this case, there is no need to worry; cinnamon is upstaged by perfectly crispy butter pastry, fresh and crunchy green apple skin, lemon curd and almond meal. All this packed into a fantastic wine with a singing acid line for good measure. Keep the pie, let's drink the wine.

International entries from all the colours of the red varietals rainbow make their mark from the crisp, acid driven reds of Etna through to the grandeur and prestige of Burgundy and Barolo. Varietals of the Iberian Peninsula are reflected both in true representations (Rioja) as well as our own (McLaren Vale, Barossa Valley).

NEBBIOLO AND BAROLO



The following selection of fully matured Barolo is as exciting as it is rare. These bottles are truly one off specialties that likely won't be around long and will become increasingly difficult to source in the near future. The two present vintages are arguably some of the best representation of the twelve years that they span and a great testament to the ageability and respect that the 'King of Wines' commands.

It is worth noting that wine of this magnitude may surpass a traditional food and beverage match. Wines such as these are not 'because' of the occasion, they simply transcend and 'become' the occasion. Expect a classic matured Barolo profile of black tea, wilted rose petals, Piedmontese truffles, leather and cured meats. This intense and rich tapestry all wrapped up in black velvet.

At 55 and 43 years old respectively, these wines will require considered and careful decanting with as much notice as possible.
